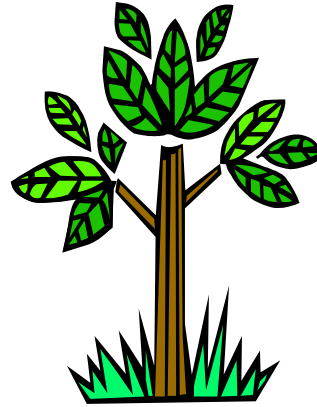
CD Sales
