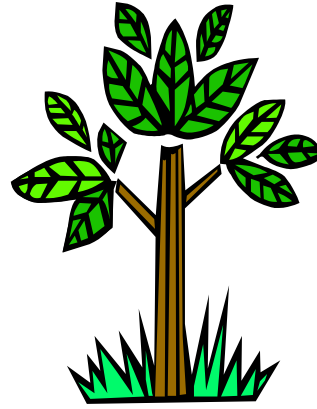
CD Sales
